- Each working day, nuclear workers are involved in safety as a priority in order to protect their health in the industrial plant
- Our target is ZERO ACCIDENT
- To reach ZERO ACCIDENT, nuclear workers request:
 - Integrate safety as a component of the job for all the workers
 - Put in place prevention especially through training

Regulatory and safety policy



- incorporate the regulatory and its developments in safety and radiological protection
- Promote a strong safety culture to be shared between nuclear workers worldwide
- Integrate nuclear safety in all processes

Dialogues

- Nuclear safety is based on an important principle of high quality dialogue with internal and external workers and public with a commitment to continous improvement
- Each nuclear worker has to be very attentive to safety of himself and his colleagues where ongoing review and sharing of experiences and lessons learnt are key drivers
- Each nuclear workers need to be sure that considerations of safety requirements are fully integrated by companies in the nuclear facilites where they work daily



Training and skills

- Nuclear workers need to develop their competencies within operational positions.
- Need to consolidate and improve safety through qualifications and through the reinforcement of training
- Need to ensure that considerations of safety requirements are fully integrated in the nuclear facilities where they work daily



Conclusions

- Energy is at heart of our lifes and has to be accessible for all the human beings worlwide
- Nuclear energy peaceful application is a primary energy allowing to limit CO2 emissions harmful to our Earth
- The requirement to use nuclear energy is a strong priority: High level of nuclear safety
